Dear Friends,

This weekend we mark Ascension day, which falls on Thursday 9 May.

It is both an end and a beginning – the end of Jesus' earthly presence with his disciples, the end of his physical companionship. But the start of his companionship by his Spirit with all of us, throughout the world, and through all time. We will celebrate this next Sunday at Pentecost.

It was after Jesus' ascension that Christians began the weekly celebration of the Lord's Supper, also known as 'the breaking of bread'. To this day when we celebrate communion and break bread together we are giving ourselves a very tangible reminder of the continuing companionship of Jesus with us. The word *companion* means 'one who eats bread with another', from the Latin words *com* (together) and *panis* (bread). And at the start of the communion prayer we say, 'The Lord is here! His Spirit is with us.'

Let's give ourselves permission to be glad when we come together to break bread in his presence! And may you know his companionship whenever you sit down to eat, whether alone or with others. Pausing to day grace before we eat is a powerful way to recognise his companionship with us and offer him our thanks and our welcome.
